

Arrangement on the agenda of

the 4th General Assembly

Overview

The 4th KoLFACI General Assembly (hereinafter GA) will be held in writing in accordance with KoLFACI Official Letter No. 23-04.

KoLFACI GA will collect signature of consent from the Member States on the agenda. The results of GA will be reflected in the operation of the KoLFACI over the next three years.

Agenda I Agreement to the election of the New Chair Group.

- 1. In accordance with the Regulation for the GA of KoLFACI (hereinafter KoLFACI Regulation), KoLFACI's Secretariat recommended the New Chair Group in alphabetical order, and the countries and representatives accepted the chairmanship position, and the contents are as follows.
 - 1.1. Chair: Edgar Esteche, President of Paraguayan Institute of Agrarian Technology (IPTA)
 - 1.2. Co-Chair: Chae-ho Cho, Administrator of Rural Development Administration
 - 1.3. Vice-Chair: Jorge Juan Ganoza Roncal, President of National Institute of Agricultural Innovation (INIA)

- **2.** The new Chair may convene, open, and close the GA, approve the records of the GA, and stipulate matters such as resolutions and holding the next GA.
 - 2.1. The other roles of the New Chair Group (Chair and Vice-Chair) are in accordance with KoLFACI Regulation.
- **3.** In principle, the next GA will be held in Paraguay, the new chair country, but it will be confirmed after consultation with Secretariat later.

Agenda II Consent to new project and the extension of the Cacao project
